The Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2007, Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005, Fire (Scotland) Act 2005 or Fire Safety Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2010 require that adequate information, instruction and training are provided for persons nominated with fire safety responsibilities.

FIRE EXTINGUISHER TRAINING

The Fire Warden course can be further enhanced by the inclusion of live fire extinguisher training.

Extinguisher practice is carried out using a propane fired simulator, which provides realistic and safe simulation of real fires. The simulator requires three car parking spaces.

This additional experience gives delegates the skills and confidence to assess and attack fires with equipment provided and reduce the likelihood of any incident developing into a major fire.
