INTRODUCTION

Improved standards of Fire Safety are becoming an area of increasing concern for industry, commerce and other workplaces. Current fire safety legislation requires a risk based regime in organisations with a nominated competent person overseeing the fire safety management responsibilities.

The programme is designed for holders of a Fire Technician qualification, ie, TIFSM, TIFPO, TIFireE etc. Upon successful completion of the course and project, it is possible to enhance professional standing to Associate (AIFSM) with the Institute of Fire Safety Managers who have accredited the course.

Delegates are given 6 months to complete the project and when produced should be a working document useful in the workplace, not just a course exercise.

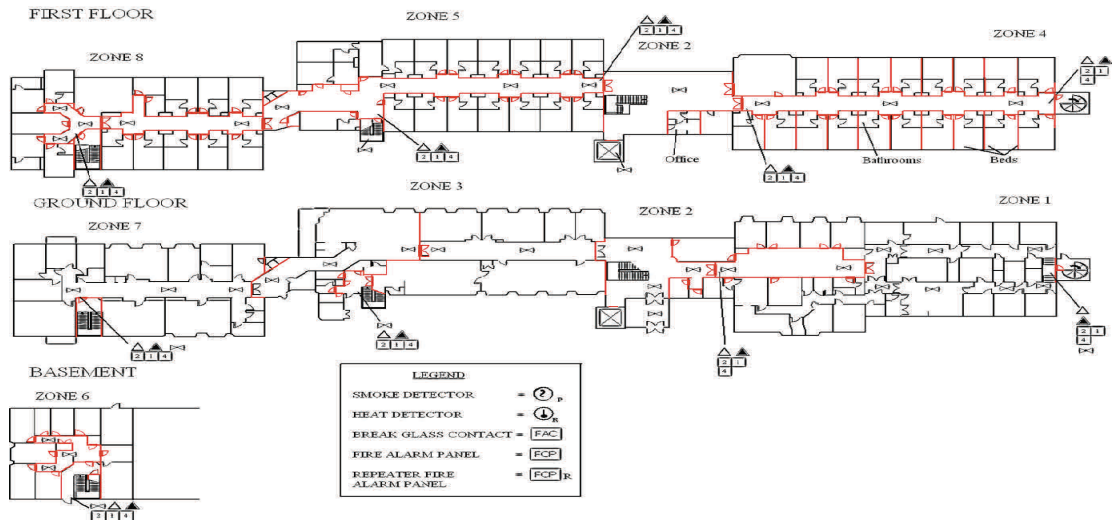
